Prescriber	Patient is being treated by a specialist (e.g. sleep disorder specialist,
Restrictions:	neurologist).
Age Restrictions:	Patient is at least 7 years of age or older.
Required Medical Information:	 Patient is not being treated with sedative hypnotics and/or CNS depressants that will be used concurrently with sodium oxybate; and Patient does not have a history of drug or alcohol abuse; and Patient is being treated for narcolepsy with cataplexy; and Patient has failed a 6 week trial of at least one of the following agents: tricyclic antidepressants, SSRIs, and/or venlafaxine; or Patient is being treated for narcolepsy without cataplexy; and Patient is being treated for narcolepsy without cataplexy; and Patient has failed, has a documented intolerance or contraindication to, modafinil.
Renewal Criteria:	Patient is continuing on therapy and clinical notes provided support efficacy of treatment.
Coverage duration:	Initial: 1 month Continuation of therapy: 3 months
