Required Medical Information:	<p>The patient must meet all of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The patient must experience persistent epithelial defects (PED) or corneal ulceration of at least 2 weeks duration refractory to one or more conventional non-surgical treatments (e.g., preservative free artificial tears). ○ Evidence of decreased corneal sensitivity (less than or equal to 4 cm using the Cochet-Bonnet. aesthesiometer) within the area of the PED or corneal ulcer and outside of the area of the defect in at least one corneal quadrant. ○ Performance of Schirmer test without anesthesia resulting in greater than 3 mm of moisture in 5 minutes ○ The patient has not received a previous course of Oxervate in the affected eye. ○ 2 yrs of age or older ○ Prescribed by an ophthalmologist ○ Counseled on proper technique ○ Provider confirms that member/caregiver has dexterity enough to perform administration
